The 'grand plan' also allows for fast helicopter access to much of our existing terrain.

The 8 Peaks Project

As anyone who has ever skied with us can attest, Blue River and the surrounding mountains are blessed to be in one of the World's most productive snow belts. The 8 Peaks project comprises areas including approximately 44,500 hectares of mountain slopes within about 15 kilometres of Blue River.

The grand plan for the 8 Peaks area consists of over 3,000 acres of developed and widely varied ski terrain. The 8 Peaks will contain:

- Permanent peak to valley ski runs
- Extensive gladed tree skiing
- Cat skiing and snowboarding
- Parkland-like skiing ranging between open traditional ski runs and closely spaced tree runs.

The project will be phased in over the next 5 to 10 years as demand and opportunities open up. Over the past summer, extensive work has been completed glading the top portion of Parmigan, improving the spacing and increasing the overall skiable area. Work was also started on Duffy's West by glading a large 40 hectare portion of terrain with varied spacing as it moves from alpine to valley bottom. Work has also begun to improve potential snowcat access in the future.

All in all, the 8 Peaks will provide excellent close range helicopter, snowcat and lift serviced skiing opportunities that can be accessed in adverse weather. Between Saddle Mountain, the 8 Peaks and the Cariboo and Monashees, MWHS will be able to secure excellent skiing for the entire length of the skiing season while avoiding adverse weather delays or closures.

More mountains, more powder, more skiing than anywhere else in the whole wide world.

The Cariboo and Monashee Mountains

Our extensive skiing area encompasses over **1700 square miles** and has over **1,000 peaks and runs**. The land resource base within the MWHS tenure area remains relatively undeveloped and affords outdoor enthusiasts an opportunity to enjoy truly unique wilderness experiences.

Looking to the west you will see the heavily glacial Caribooos and the many ski routes descending from the peaks to the deeply forested valley floors. Looking to the east as you travel up through the North Thompson Valley will unveil the majestic and rugged Monashee Mountain Range. Everything here is massive, the peaks, the precipices, the glaciers and the ski runs. Some Highlights include:

- Highest landing at 11,600 ft, lowest pickup at 3,400 feet
- Typical accumulation of 30 feet (9 metres) of high quality, reliable powder snow
- Terrain for intermediate to advanced skiers
- Terrain for experts
- Glacier skiing swooping through huge mountain peaks where 300 to 600 consecutive turns are common
- Tree skiing in deep snow through natural and man made glades

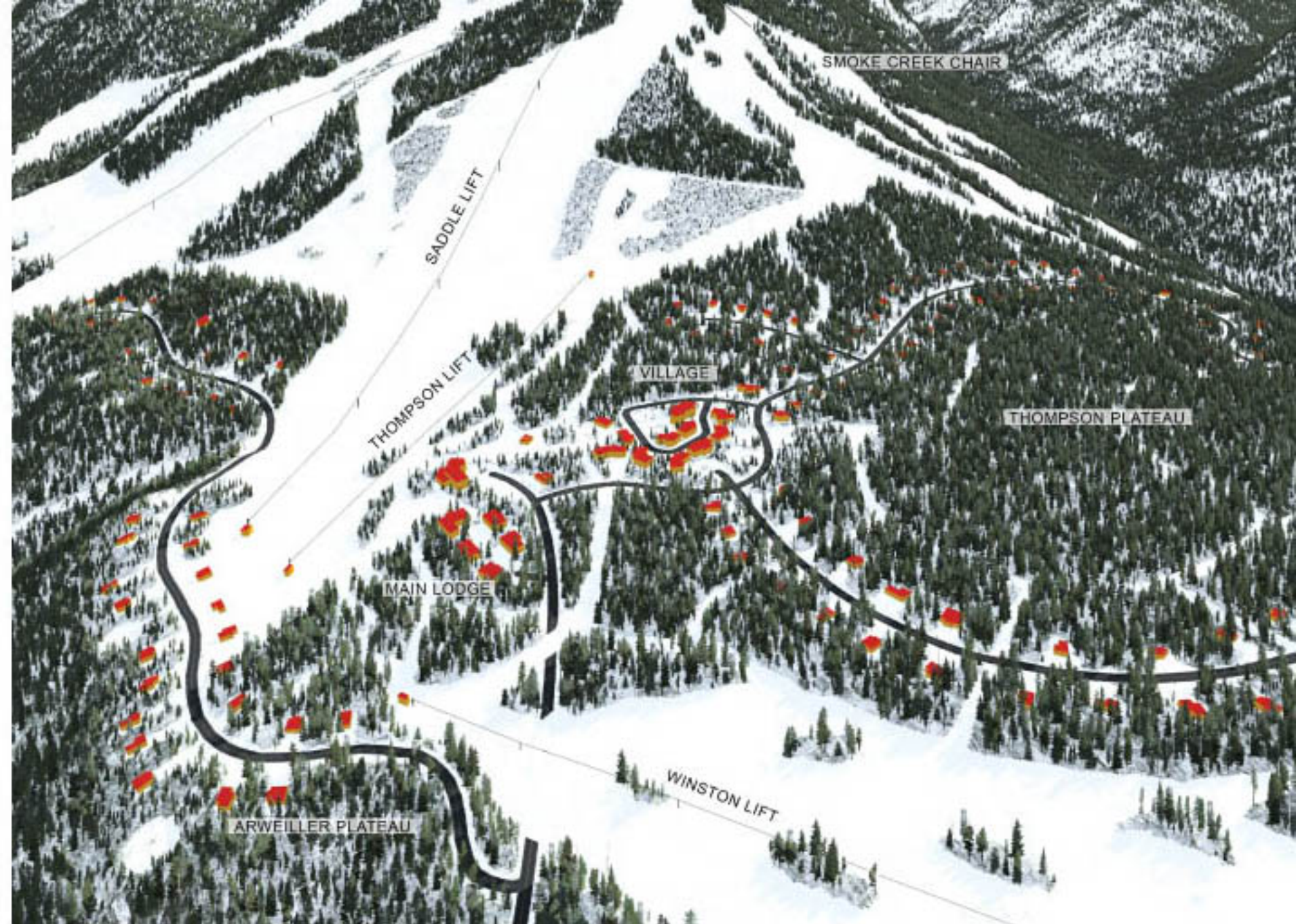
We now have a unique opportunity to plan, design and build the kind of ski resort that simply does not exist anywhere else in the world. A ski resort served by ski lifts, snowcats, and helicopters and set in the centre of the world's most magnificent skiing mountains and most accessible powder snow.

All facilities will allow panoramic views of the surrounding countryside overlooking the Thompson Valley into the Cariboo and Monashee Glacier Mountain Peaks.

The village location on Thompson Plateau is at 3,400 feet elevation - a relatively easy adjustment for those not accustomed to high elevations. The higher-than-average-elevation (compared to other BC resorts) is high enough to stay out of the valley fog. The 8 Peaks ski runs are accessible by snowcat and helicopter.

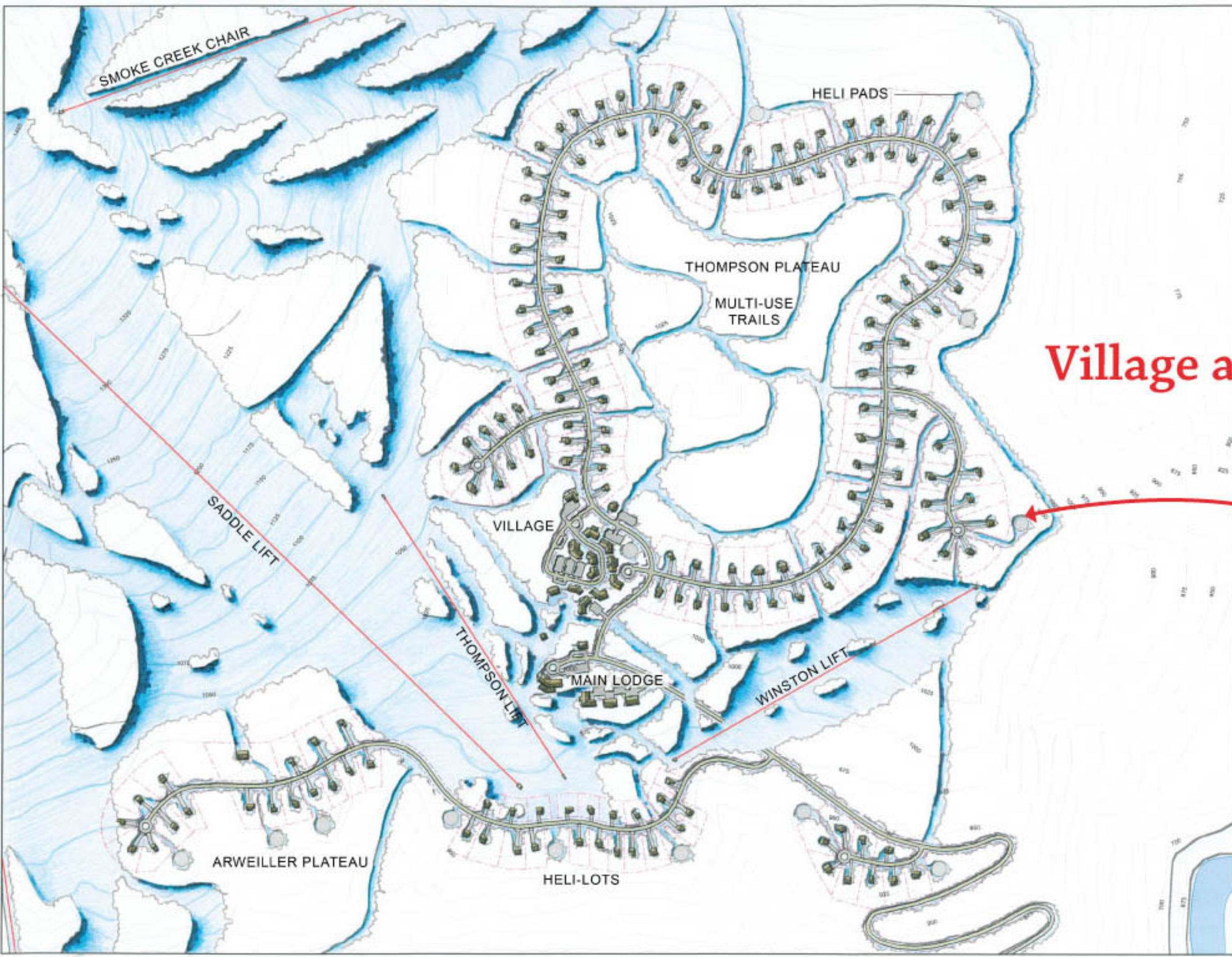
The village is to be designed and placed to allow harmonious access and flow of ski in - ski out from living quarters to lodges - lifts - snowcats - helicopters - pickups and other means of travel in the village. The village should be conveniently located in proximity to other recreation and wellness activities and facilities. "No motorized vehicles other than service vehicles"

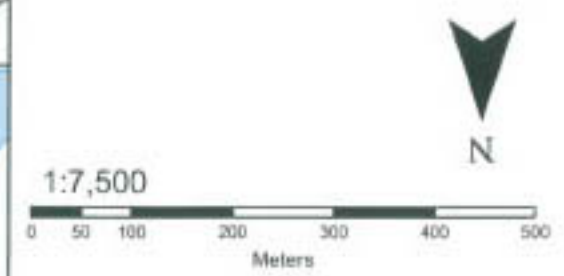
